Designs and conducts advanced analytics and reports to support data driven decision making and development of best practices for the organization. Builds and maintains financial models for energy proposals and economic development with respect to feasibility, scenario analysis, cash flows and capital structures to support decision making. Runs sensitivities and scenarios based on capacity, costs, revenue, regulations and other factors. Models equity and debt to optimize capital structure. Responsible for Market research, data mining, business intelligence on energy and economic development: Conducts external research to support strategic energy planning and decision-making including market research, data mining, business intelligence and valuation comps. Financial and business management reporting, research reports, status reports: Creates and maintains databases of relevant research data, financial reporting and operating data related to energy investment and development. Administration activities: Assists with budget and performance reporting processes. Assists in project management related to Energy Office strategic initiatives. Supports ad hoc activities as required
