DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Plans, organizes, implements big game and furbearer management within the Management/Research Section of the Department of Fish and Wildlife. Designs study plans, prepares technical and non-technical reports; makes presentations before Navajo Nation government agencies, the general public and outside agencies; may testify before governing and policy-making bodies; formulates long and short-term work plans and strategies for big game and furbearers including development of a Big Game and Furbearer Management Plan. Big game species include black bear, mountain lion, rocky mtn. elk, mule deer, pronghorn, desert bighorn sheep and Merriam's turkey. Furbearers include coyote, bobcat, foxes, beaver, badger, muskrat, skunks, raccoons and weasels. The position is also responsible for supervising Wildlife technicians that are responsible for collecting data and implementing habitat enhancement projects. Assigns, directs and reviews work of staff, evaluates employee's work performance, ensures compliance with established policies.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Wildlife Biology, Wildlife Management or a related field; and three (3) years of experience in wildlife management or wildlife biology experience.

Special Requirements:

- Valid State's Driver's License.

(To receive full credit for education, certification, or licensure, transcripts, copies of degrees, certificates, and other appropriate documents must be submitted along with employment application.)

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of federal, state and tribal laws, biological principles.
