DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The position will provide daily care for livestock & bison and ranch operations. Oversee pasture management, supplemental feeding, daily care and monitoring health of all livestock and bison. Report of weekly and monthly livestock related activities; animal health, weather conditions, facility conditions, forage and feed consumption. A major goal is to maximize breeding rates, weaning rates and minimize death loss to ensure long-term profitability of the ranch enterprise.
