DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Independently undertakes and conducts environmental studies that include but aren't limited to monitoring and enforcing prescribed regulations that pertain to the clean up of environmentally hazardous sites that include pesticide violations, archeological processes; collects samples and analyzes; plans and coordinates the closure of open land fills; assures compliance with established environmental policies, procedures, initiates corrective environmental action by determining most reasonable approach in obtaining compliance with established regulations; coordinates with departments, agency representatives, community leaders and others in resolving complaints and violations, notifying supervisory staff regarding non-compliance findings; adheres to directives including environmental, threatened and endangered species; assures compliance with established environmental polices, procedures and directives of the assigned programs; schedules and provides pubic information/education to the general public, departments/programs and public officials; develop technical reports, weekly reports; review environmental documents for sufficiency in the 164 legislative process.
