DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Oversees and directly supervises the personnel in the construction, repair and maintenance of community and livestock water facilities; provides direction, guidance and instruction; schedules and assigns duties; supervises and assists with the operation and use of pneumatic tools, welding, and other equipment; maintains records, materials, supplies, equipment, and facilities; instructs subordinates with work quality and projections; prepares project status reports; keep and update cost reports, daily work reports, and submit to central office on scheduled basis; ensures that assigned tribal vehicle and equipment's are in good working condition; interpret and understand technical and engineering drawings of water systems and their infrastructures; attend meetings i.e.. chapter, state, federal, other entities, and other departments to represent program. Must adhere to Drug and Alcohol Free Workplace policy of Navajo Nation.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED; and two (2) years of supervisory or lead experience in the construction, maintenance and repair of community and livestock water facilities; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid state driver's license.
