Provides and conducts community traffic safety awareness presentations on topics that include: Seatbelt Awareness, Child Passenger Safety, DUI/DWI Awareness, Distracted Driving, Car Fit Mature Driver's Training, Defensive Driving Courses, etc. to communities within the Western Agency of the Navajo Nation. Plans, organizes and conducts outreach activities within the Western Agency by collaborating with injury prevention partners. Provides Child Passenger Safety Education and works on establishing a Car Seat Program in Western Agency. Works with local school districts to conduct presentations and school-based education programs for all-age levels with an emphasis on Teen (Youth) Drivers. Collects data and surveys for Seatbelt Usage, Distracted Driving and Child Passenger throughout the communities in Western Agency.

- Associate's Degree in Traffic Safety, Public Health, Industrial Safety, Safety Engineering or a closely related field with advanced training in Occupational Safety and Health or area of assignment; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
