Provide heavy equipment operation on water conservations projects such as; earthen dams/reservoirs well site preparations, water system rehabilitation including land restoration projects. Provide assistance with heavy equipment's in emergencies by the Navajo Nation. Maintain and upkeep maintenance on all assigned fleet and construction equipment's. Perform daily inspections and assist equipment mechanics on equipment maintenance and repairs. Keep and provide reports on all assigned duties upon completion of projects. Have updated required certification of Federal/Commercial Drivers' License; Endorsement and Medical Certification.
