DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Serve as veterinarian for the new Navajo Nation Veterinary Mobile Unit, provide disease diagnosis and prescribe treatment for disease and disorders of animals; primarily for small animal wellness clinics (vaccinations, deworming & tick control measures) for all pets that arrive to the NNVMU on day 1 of services at predetermined chapter sites and oversee contract surgeons for day 2 of spay & neuter services; supervise staff of the Veterinary Mobile Unit, maintain patient records and documentation of services provided; ability to complete additional surgeries on the NNVMU; Understand that this position is an emergency hire in response to the Centers of Disease & Prevention EpiAid Report of RMSF risk on the Navajo Nation; ability to educate pet owners on the importance of tick control for the prevention of Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever; Program expects to hire immediately until the end of the funding cycle which is September 30, 2013.
