**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Under general supervision, performs entry level skilled plumbing work of routine nature; installs and repairs simple new or existing sewage, water and gas distribution lines; performs related work as assigned  
Performs routine plumbing work independently in preparation for the July 4th Celebration and Navajo Nation Fair; accomplishes tasks according to prescribed instructions and standard plumbing methods; installs, modifies and repairs damaged distribution lines; assures piping installations conform with prescribed blueprint and building plans; makes appropriate calculations according to prescribed specification; solders/welds plumbing joints for proper seal; installs coupling, unions, traps, valves and joints; performs test on new and/or repaired plumbing lines or fixtures throughout the NN Fairgrounds and facilities.  
Prepares written work cost and estimates for materials; Inspects structures to assess material and equipment needs; performs preventative maintenance and seasonal start up/close down of air conditioning units and equipment; cleans, changes filters, inspects and adjusts belts; lubricates motor and checks water and gas lines for leaks; repairs and replaces furnaces, unit heaters, water heaters and swamp coolers

A high school diploma or GED; and two (2) years of progressive apprenticeship work in the plumbing trade

**Preferred Qualifications:**
