**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Perform complex electrical work assignments, repair, installation, and modification of electrical distribution lines in a wide range of electrical voltage and power. Installs electrical or extends electrical circuits for outlets and exterior lighting, installs conduit and pull wires through walls; services heating furnaces and water heaters. Reads; interprets and lays out work plan according to prescribed drawings, sketches, blueprints, wiring diagrams, floor plans and scope of work. Maintains and upgrades wires; dedicated circuits, heating and cooling equipment's junction boxes. Upgrades electrical apparatus; replaces bearings on motors, troubleshoots and repairs solar systems. Completes wire installation, conduct "rough-in and trim-out" work. Conducts cost estimate of materials, orders supplies and materials. Schedule material delivery with construction vendors. Maintains, repairs and replaces ballasts, sockets, starters, outlets. Installs or replaces transformers, breakers, capacitors, fuses, thermostats, heating elements. Completes required reports, work orders, project status reports. Attend staff meetings

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)**

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- High school diploma/GED; and four (4) years of progressively responsible journey level commercial or residential electrical installation and repair experience.
