**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Prepares meals in quantities according to prescribed menu and number of persons to be served; maintains inventory of food supplies and equipment; estimates daily/weekly needs and orders/purchases food supplies and equipment; operates standard kitchen equipment; collects and compiles statistics related to meals prepared/served, client information, etc.; prepares and submits required reports; maintains clean and sanitary conditions of kitchen, storage room, refrigerator, stoves, and other equipment in compliance with OEH standards; maintains strict sanitary conditions in regard to dishes, utensil, and kitchen linens; seeks assistance from other community agencies to successfully provide services to the elderly; will assist and plan activities for elderly within scope of Senior Center operations; other duties as require or assigned.
