DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Transports passengers to specified locations; assists with loading and unloading passengers; picks up and delivers materials and supplies to designated office/business; verifies and prepares pick up and/or deliveries; complies with all applicable traffic laws and regulations and program policies and procedures; maintains and ensures safety and comfort of passengers. Performs routine inspections of van; performs preventative maintenance and minor repairs; reports any problems or repairs needed; maintains trip log by recording travel mileage, fuel and maintenance expenses; cleans and washes vans; may conduct and participate in safety drills and presentations attends meetings; prepares required reports. In addition to responsibilities listed, may assist in preparing, serving and delivering meals to client's homes; may assist with intake and referrals.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- One (1) year of experience in driving a van, delivery van or light truck. Must have a clean driving record for the past (5) years.

Preferred Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED.
- Two (2) years of experience in driving.
- Commercial Driver's License (CDL).

Special Requirements:

- A favorable background investigation.
- Pass a physical examination.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of operation and preventative maintenance on a passenger or cargo van; federal, state and local traffic rules and regulations; occupations safety and health rules and regulations; transporting passengers; customer service and public relations practices; geographical area and map reading; maintaining records, reports and logs. Must be skilled in safely operating and transporting passengers; in safely and accurately picking up and delivering a variety of goods, materials and supplies; in performing preventative maintenance on assigned vehicles; in utilizing customer service techniques when responding to inquiries, requests and complaints; in establishing and maintaining effective working relationships. Ability to follow oral and written instructions. Driver will be responsible for part of the statistical reporting. Computer skills are recommended. Must be willing to attend trainings, assist with program activities on and off reservation. Must be willing to take leadership in special assignments, assist in exercise activities with elderly participants.
