DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Research right-of-ways and land status for new WMI equipment; maintains field notes, descriptions, sketches and all other pertinent field data collected; assists in construction projects; assists with estimating labor, materials, equipment and cost for construction projects. Acquires data from the field, downloads data from various sources, and inputs data into computer databases; performs simple hydraulic calculations, estimates weight, volume and quantity using field notes; gathers and processes data from precipitation storage gauges, monitoring wells, windmills, automated weather stations, stream gauging, data loggers, belford storage gauges, snow surveys, photo points, well, cross sections of fields and streams; assists with the design of various gauges, selection of data collection locations, delineation of flood plains by providing refined and reliable hydrological data; utilizes ArcGIS and applicable software to develop drawings/maps and reduce field notes; makes copies of topographical maps and drawings.
