Performs preventive maintenance and service on tractor trucks, forklifts; performs checks on brakes; lights, tires; fluid levels; electrical and air lines; greases equipment; gauges; completes inspection; utilizes welders; air compressors; air tools; charges batteries; changes oil; performs replacement on axle seal; bearing; major repairs; trouble-shooting on all work to be performed on equipment and trucks; diagnostic and ensure that equipment are in good safe working condition; delivery of fuel; winterization preparation and inspection on all program equipment; completes work order and reporting repairs needing to be completed

Required to travel to remote area location, driving in adverse weather condition and exposure to potentially hazardous chemical; maintains clean area; responsible for diesel fuel delivery
