Provides public education on the commodity program, conducts nutrition education; cooking procedures; food safety; education on proper methods of storing commodities; preparation of educational material incorporating culturally nutrition education; conducts home visits to home bound eligible household upon request, may assist clients with completing application to determine eligibility; may assist with processing commodity shopping lists utilizing an automatic inventory system, cleans cooking area and utensils; attend meeting and training on nutrition education; collaborates with the Indian Health Services, Nutritionist, Diabetes Program; Health Education Program an other Navajo Nation, Federal, State and counties offices regarding nutritional guidance and nutrition education materials, disseminates information on the use and storage of commodities through fact sheets, posters and presentations.

- An Associates Degree in Health, Health Education or related field and two (2) years experience providing nutrition education in a community, school or hospital setting; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
