DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general supervision, performs semi-skilled work of routine difficulty in the maintenance of parks, buildings, camp/picnic grounds, signs and recreational facilities; performs related work as assigned. Constructs, installs, and repairs benches, tables, shelters, fences, signs, trails, comfort stations and related facilities and equipment at viewpoints, campgrounds, picnic areas, rest areas, parks and other recreation areas; uses power and hand tools and other related equipment; maintains supplies, materials, equipment, and facilities; erects and installs signs at park and recreation areas. Picks up and deposits refuse, discards building materials and other items; provides janitorial and related services to public facilities, building office and ground; responds to inquiries from the public, assists clerks and other staff. Performs materials estimates; and skills in communicating effectively to obtain quotations from vendors for projects; the greatest skills this job requires is to build or construct something that requires accurate measurements to fit all pieces together.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED; and two (2) years experience in construction, maintenance, parks and facility maintenance.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Proficient in the use of power and hand tools.

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid state driver's license.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:
