DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general supervisor perform a variety of unskilled or semi-skill manual duties of routine difficulty requiring limited knowledge of techniques, tool and equipment; assist Park Maintenance Worker, electricians, constructions, supervisor with related daily routine assignment by projects; use various hand and power tools; loading and unloading supplies, office equipment and/or furniture; perform general work in servicing of tribal parks areas; repairing and installing barricades, setting posts, building and replacing fences; perform miscellaneous repair, labor and maintenance work; maintains building and worksite free of debris; routine janitorial duties in collecting and disposing of trash, sweeping, mopping, cleans and care for tools and equipment; provide customer service to visitors by answering questions concerning the tribal parks areas; recreational opportunities, distributes maps, brochures and other printed materials implements other duties as assigned by Supervisor.
