DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Operates 5 ton semi-truck with trailer to deliver food commodities; operates forklift to load or unload food items; ability to lifting and carrying food commodities weighing up to 50 pounds; determines the amount of food to be loaded onto truck taking into consideration the weight of food and pallet; conducts physical inventory of food commodity loaded onto truck for distribution; records damaged food items and keep record of food issued; records the daily load list, assist warehouse worker with daily food issuance using automated system using computer generating shopping list; sweeps and mops floors whenever necessary; pick up trash around warehouse; may perform truck and equipment preventive maintenance

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED; and one (1) year of experience operating and maintaining a 5 ton semi-tractor

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL - Class A) and Medical Card.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:
