DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Incumbent shall develop, implement and coordinate a variety of recreational programming (indoor/outdoor) for groups through on-site and outreach program sites, such as: Youth Camps, Leagues, Health/Wellness Activities, Runs/Walks, Team-Building/Ice-breakers, Recreation/Sport activities and Nutritional Education. Must have ability to utilize curriculums and to teach youth about healthy living and life styles. Conducts surveys and research to evaluate and to determine needs and interests of adolescents and youth. Attend meetings to work with schools, the community/chapters and interest groups to understand trends and needs of the youth and to disseminate information, determine recreational needs and opportunities. Serves as front-line staff to ensure delivery of services which include communication and interaction and development of recreational/wellness activities, as well in the areas of teamwork, physical activity, education pursuits, participation in non-competitive activities. Plans, develops, organizes and conducts in-service and related training for staff and volunteers in the area of teamwork, leadership, stress management, etc. Promotes a network of partnerships with local educational and youth service organizations for support, integration and coordination of services. Ability to supervise program support staff, when necessary; Prepares reports and statistics, forms and activity proposals. And other duties, as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree in Recreation, Physical Education, Exercise Science, Sports Administration or closely related field; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Requirements:

- A favorable background investigation.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:
