**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Work in assigned chapters (4-5 chapters) to identify and map food related resources and obstacles; assess local participation in USDA anti-hunger programs and ways to improve access and reduce barriers to programs; Assess local food production to identify opportunities for local food in USDA programs; Work with local schools, government organizations (such as chapter houses), community organizations, senior centers, food stores and food producers to spread information about USDA anti-hunger programs and advocate for increased use of these programs.

Searches multiple sources, such as reference works, literature, documents, newspapers and statistical records to obtain data on assigned subject; recruits individual for participation in research study; assists in the development of survey instruments; records participant's responses to questionnaires; conducts interviews with individual to obtain data and may tape record information; contact participants to ensure complete responses are received for survey data; correlates group discussions to acquire information relevant to the research subject; establishes and maintains records of research data, participants and supplies; analyzes and evaluates applicability of collected data; prepares reports or presents data in formats such as abstracts, bibliographies or graphs.

- A high school diploma or GED; and one (1) year of experience involving the survey collection of statistical, demographic and/or research analysis.
