DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Oversees and directly supervises the personnel in the drilling, water storage tank construction, repair and maintenance of livestock water facilities; provides direction, guidance and instruction; schedules and assigns duties; conducts field inspections of drilling construction activities; supervises and assists with the operation and use of pneumatic tools, welding, drill rig and other equipment used in drilling construction activities; maintains records, materials, supplies, equipment, diesel fuel and facilities for accountability; ensures work quality and compliance with all construction related applicable policies, procedures, laws, rules, regulations and permitting requirement; prepares project cost estimates, project cost reports and progress reports; ensure updates for daily work reports, and submit to central office on schedules basis; ensures that assigned tribal vehicle and equipment are in good working condition, understand and interprets technical and engineering drawings of water systems and water related infrastructure; makes program related presentations and represents TCOB/DWR in meetings with department, chapters, private, state and federal agencies; must adhere to Drug and Alcohol Free Work place policy of Navajo Nation. Knowledgeable with State and Federal requirements for transpiration of equipment (including wide/oversize load) and Commercial Drivers License, permits.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or GED; and two (2) years of supervisory experience in the construction and maintenance of livestock water infrastructures and rules, and regulations of transporting heavy equipment.

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid state driver's license.
- Incumbent must obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) within one (1) year of date of hire. Incumbent will be subject to random drug and alcohol testing per regulations as a CDL driver.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of: Applicable federal, state and local standards and regulations related to construction; practices, procedures, and methods of construction, maintenance and repair; tools, equipment and materials used in construction, maintenance and repair activities; project management and scheduling techniques; occupational hazards and safety procedures; principles and practices of employee supervision, training and evaluation.

Skilled in: Preparing scope of work, construction plans and specifications; scheduling and directing construction and maintenance tasks; implementing and monitoring budgets; inspecting and evaluating drilling construction, maintenance and repair activities; supervising, training, evaluating employees and scheduling work assignments and activities; establishing and maintaining effective work relationships and communicating effectively.

Physical Requirements and work environment: There is considerable need to stand, stoop, climb, walk, carry and perform other similar actions during the course of the workday. Must be capable of lifting/carry materials, equipment, supplies in excess of 100 pounds; climbing to heights of 40 feet or more; working confined spaces; working in all types of weather conditions.
