DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under general direction, performs security work of routine difficulty; performs security and watchman duties by patrolling, observing, and maintaining watch over Monument Valley Tribal Park facilities, equipment, materials and supplies; inspects, examines, checks locks, doors, windows, enclosures, fences, and gates to ensure that they are secured; guards against theft, vandalism, fire, illegal entry or use of equipment and facilities; detects and responds to illegal and questionable activities and reports deficiencies and performs related work as assigned.

Operates communication equipment to report emergencies, vandalism, irregular or unauthorized activities and serious violations and threat to the security of assigned area; admits authorized staff into building/facilities after working hours; maintain keys, equipment, facilities, materials, supplies and may be required to prepare and submit reports; observes safety regulations.

Makes minor emergency repairs; performs custodial duties as needed; repairs electrical outlets and lighting fixtures on interior/exterior walls; answers telephone calls; serves as tour guide greeting visitors, answering questions, provide information pertaining to the Park and other park areas; may give tours of assigned facilities to visitors, schools, civic organizations.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Training:

A high school diploma or GED.

To receive full credit for education/training applicant must submit transcripts, certificates, diploma, etc.

Experience:

One (1) year experience in responsible building maintenance and security work; or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience which provides the capabilities to perform the described duties.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Work involves moderate walking with some lifting, stooping, climbing on a regular basis.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Knowledge of common fire hazards and prevention; fire alarm system; emergency communication systems; skills in reading and writing of the English language; detecting malfunctions in building equipment and other hazards; in observing activities going on around one's work area; maintain constant vigilance while on duty; establish and maintain effective working relationships.

License/Certification Requirements:

Must possess a valid state drivers license and obtain a Navajo Nation Tribal Permit. Background check required for all applicants.
