DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Recommends and participates in planning, and developing appropriate education policies for the program and Department of Dine' Education. Provides technical assistance to all schools on the Navajo Nation to pursue grant or contract status by providing training to meet tribal requirements. Will assist in the establishment, convening and training of the School Improvement Team and assist the Team Chair to prepare required reports based on school visits. Will assist in the monitor, assessment and review of school operations and programs pursuant to PL 93-638 contract and PL 100-297 grant; facilitate the tribal organization process for BIE schools converting to contract or grant status. Provide technical assistance in developing school improvement for all schools, and assist with training of local school boards, as needed.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Education and Training:

A Bachelor's degree in Elementary, Secondary Education or related field; and

Experience:

four (4) years in the education field including classroom teaching and Supervisory responsibility; or and equivalent combination of education, training and experience which provides the capabilities to perform the described duties.

Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

Strong knowledge of Navajo and State Education Standards and Policies; and Federal rules and regulations in PL 93-638, PL 100-297, and PL 95-561. Must have strong knowledge in PC computers in spreadsheet, data networking, graphics, MSWord and Excel, compiling and analyzing school information via annual reports through WWWeb-Internet. Must be knowledgeable of Indian education laws, including No Child Left Behind Act.

License/Certification Requirements:

Elementary or Secondary Teaching/School Administrator Certification Preferred. Applicant must be certified (licensured) in Education either from the States of NM, AZ or UT. This Education Specialist will work with all Navajo schools where education personnel is highly qualified & certified in accordance with education laws. The schools OMETA works with are requesting that DODE staff that directly work with schools all be certified. This is the purpose for a special qualifying requirement for Education Specialist.
