DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provides physical labor assistance to all Department for Self Reliance (DSR) offices including one administration office and eight direct service offices. Performs standard assembling and disassembling of office furnishings, fixtures, file cabinets, drawers, and chairs. May perform some carpentry maintenance tasks including painting and texturing and door and hardware installation; paints interior of building as appropriate. Performs and conducts periodic inventory audits and reconciles physical office furnishing, office supplies, and office equipment. Manages arrangement for transfer of office furnishings and rotation as appropriate. Develops and maintains recordkeeping of work orders and internal controls. Arranges transportation of office furnishing and or delivery of goods and office supplies to appropriate DSR field office. Conducts monthly inspections of the tribal vehicles assigned to the DSR Support Services office and cleans as necessary; transports vehicles to Navajo Nation Fleet Management for appropriate maintenance. May perform custodial maintenance duties such as dusting, mopping, vacuuming & shampooing carpets, changing light bulbs, etc. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

Preferred Qualifications:

- Six months of trades, construction, warehousing, grounds, landscaping or maintenance experience.

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid state driver's license.
- Within 90 days of hire date, must obtain a Navajo Nation Vehicle Operator's Permit.
