**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Ability to operate semi-tractor truck with 4,000 gallon water tank; receiving and delivering safe drinking water to designated water hauling sites. Ability to perform post/pre-trip inspections of assigned equipment. Maintain daily driver logs and consumer delivery records, water hauling records and other reports/forms necessary for accountability and expense tracking. Ability to perform water sample testing as needed to ensure safe drinking water. Operate various heavy equipment's i.e.. backhoe, dozer, excavator, etc. to complete program objectives. Maintain semi-tractor truck, water pumps and testing equipment's. Attend various meetings to discuss program objectives, enlist families for water delivery; work with various entities at designated water hauling sites. Attend specialized training necessary to ensure compliance with Safe Drinking Water standards.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

**Education and Training:**

High school graduate or GED certificate.

**Experience:**

One year experience operating and maintaing heavy equipment (semi-tractor truck and other heavy equipment)

**In order to receive full credit for education, certification, or licensure, transcripts, copies of degrees, certificates, and other appropriate documents must be submitted along with the employment application.**

**Special Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

Knowledge of: Basic and safe operation and maintenance of heavy equipment; basic construction practices and procedures; occupational safety guidelines, practices, and procedures; repair, replacement and maintenance of water operating systems and facilities; operating, maintaining and repairing a variety of hand and power tools; or an equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the capabilities to perform the described duties.

Skilled in: Safe operation and maintenance of heavy equipment and machinery; basic construction and maintenance assignments; following verbal and written instructions and diagrams; preparing basic written reports; maintaining inventory of supplies, tools and equipment's; following safety practices and procedures related to construction work sites; establishing and maintaining effective working relationships.

Physical Requirements: Must be capable of lifting/carrying materials, equipment, supplies in excess of 100 pounds; climbing to heights of 40 feet or more; working in confined spaces; working in all types of weather conditions.
