DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Supervise the Water Code staff on a daily basis. Prepare monthly and quarterly reports. Assist with annual program budget. Assist other Department branches, program, etc. with strategic planning. Ensure water code compliance and other applicable regulations. Analyze water use and drilling permit applications, allocation of water, etc. Coordinate with other DWR branches, programs, etc. for evaluation of water sources for various projects. Prepare engineering reports, projects evaluations, etc. Conduct inspections for water and drilling permits activities, etc. and maintain all related records. Coordinate water use disputes with legal counsel for resolutions. Provide assistance to local, state and federal agencies for understanding of the Navajo Nation Water Code water use and drilling permits, application and usage fees.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: (Education, Experience and Training)

Minimum Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering or related engineering field; and two (2) years responsible work experience as a Civil Engineer and/or related work in public infrastructure construction.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Two (2) years of experience in survey, civil engineer design and plans and project and construction management, cost exterminating equipment and safety.
- Proficient in the use of surveying, civil engineering software/hardware applications.
- Possess an Engineer in Training (EIT) Certificate.

Special Requirements:

- Possess a valid state driver's license.
