**DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Ability to operate semi-tractor truck with 4,000 gallon water tank; receiving and delivering safe drinking water to designated water hauling sites. Ability to perform post/pre-trip inspections of assigned equipment. Maintain daily driver logs and consumer delivery records, water hauling records and other reports/forms necessary for accountability and expense tracking. Ability to perform water sample testing as needed to ensure safe drinking water. Operate various heavy equipments ie. backhoe, dozer, excavator, etc. to complete program objectives. Maintain semi-tractor truck, water pumps and testing equipments. Attend various meetings to discuss program objectives, enlist families for water delivery; work with various entities at designated water hauling sites. Attend specialized training necessary to ensure compliance with Safe Drinking Water standards.
